

## **South Carolina Psychiatric Association (SCPA)**

### **2012 Exhibitor Prospectus**

Please read and familiarize yourself with the SCPA Exhibitor Contract and the Exhibitor Registration Form. Submitting your forms for the exhibit space signifies that you accept the terms and conditions in this Prospectus. Exhibitors are permitted to distribute descriptive product literature and products of their own manufactures, providing such distribution is in keeping with the educational and professional character of the SCPA meeting.

1. Only companies with a product or service directly related to the field of psychiatry will be considered. The Executive Council of the SCPA reserves the right to reject an Exhibitor Registration Form, cancel or refuse rental of display space to any person or company whose conduct or display of goods is, in the opinion of the Board, incompatible with the general character and educational objectives of the Annual Meeting and the policies of the SCPA.
2. As a condition of your contract and as a courtesy of convention registrants and to your fellow exhibitors, it is expected that your exhibit will be open on time and be reasonably staffed throughout the entire meeting until the final closing time.
3. All information included in the Prospectus becomes a part of the contract between the exhibitor and the SCPA. These policies have been formulated in the best interest of the exhibitors. All points not covered are subject to the decision of the SCPA Executive Council.
4. The SCPA reserves the right to restrict or evict exhibits which become objectionable or detract from the general character of the exhibits as a whole. This includes persons, things, conduct, printed material or anything or a character which the SCPA Executive Council determines, in its opinion, as objectionable to the exhibit. In the event of such restriction or eviction, the SCPA is not liable for any refunds of exhibit expenses. Entities that receive such notice may not be eligible at future SCPA meetings.
5. The SCPA Executive Council shall have full power to interpret or amend these rules, and its decisions are final.
